There is only one Master Communicator, and we would be wise to learn from Him (John 1:1,14; Matt.1:23; Phil.2:6-9; Matt.11:29).

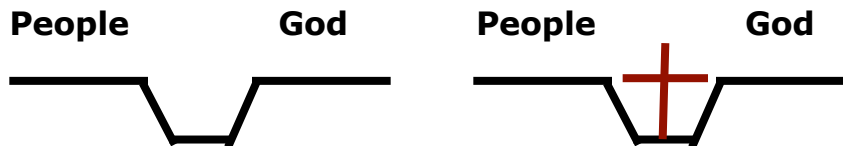
