Text: John 6:1-15

Introduction: *The church of Jesus Christ is oftentimes described in the New Testament as, “Christ’s body” (Romans 12:5; I Cor. 10:16&17 ; 11:27,29; 12:13, 27; Eph. 1:23; 3:6; 4:4, 12, 16, 26; 5:23, 30; Col. 1:18&24; 2L19; 3:15). When any one member is not where he/she should be, or functioning as he/she should be, the whole body suffers (I Cor. 12:26) and the church is incomplete. There is great joy in heaven when even one lost sheep finds their way to Jesus (Luke 15), and God has called you and I to be a part of the search and rescue team that finds those lost sheep.*
